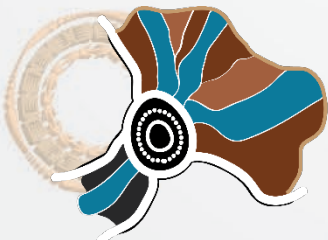

Eligibility

You must:

- Have applied for a QATSIF Round 16 Scholarship.
- Be of Aboriginal and / or Torres Strait Islander descent.
- Be enrolled as a Year 11 student at a Queensland school in the Brisbane, Townsville, Cairns or Bamaga / Thursday Island regions.
- Maintain a school attendance of over 85% or more.
- Have an interest in a future career based on providing a safe, positive environment for Indigenous families (eg. law, counselling, social work, community development etc.)

What you'll receive

In addition to receiving a QATSIF – QIFVLS Scholarship of \$2,000 (funded by QIFVLS) over a two-year period to assist with your educational expenses, you will also receive:

- Opportunities to experience what a career in QIFVLS could look like.
- If possible, visits and work experience at a QIFVLS office.
- Access to life readiness skills ie. healthy relationship, keeping yourself safe etc.
- Additional supports provided by QIFVLS.

How to Apply

To apply for the QIFVLS Barry Doyle School Based Scholarship, you must:

- Fully complete the attached application form and submit a written response of no more than 400 words for each of the following questions:
 1. *Describe your personal attributes that makes you an ideal candidate of the Barry Doyle School Based Scholarship? E.g. community involvement, career aspirations, motivation, goal setting, etc.*

 3. *Describe how the Barry Doyle SBS will assist you in your future career aspirations?*

In partnership with the Queensland Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Foundation (QATSIF), the Barry Doyle School Based Scholarship has been formulated by Queensland Indigenous Family Violence Legal Service (QIFVLS) to honour the memory and contribution that Barry made to its service over a period of 10 years.

The underpinning value is his life was supporting youth and keeping communities safe, so it is fitting that the aim of this scholarship is to address the financial barriers that youth find in wanting to complete schooling and transition to a working life and / or further study.

Education and awareness are the key to reducing violence.

This Bursary is a two-year Scholarship to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students commencing Year 11.
