

Mueller College Presentation Night – 2020 Awards Criteria

Dux of the School

The Dux of the School is awarded to the student who has achieved the highest ATAR score across in 2020, as determined by QTAC.

Criteria:

- ATARs are calculated based on student results and subject scaling across student's best five subjects.
- The best score as published by QTAC will be awarded the Dux of the school at the Mega Chapel service on the first day of the 2021 academic year.
- In the event of identical ATARs there will be dual Dux awards presented.
- The final decision of the Mueller College Dux is at the discretion of the Head of College.

Middle School Dux

The Middle School dux is awarded to the student who achieves the highest grades across their five core subjects and three elective subjects in Year Nine.

Criteria:

- It is a point-in-time judgement made at the end of Term Three in the academic year of study.
- Only work from Year Nine will be counted.
- The student must have completed three terms of study at Mueller College, in each subject, to be eligible for the award.
- In the event of a close result student performance against one another in the core subjects will be taken into account.
- The final decision of the Middle School Mueller College Dux is at the discretion of the Head of College.

The Mueller Academic Medal

The Mueller Academic Medal is a new award which will be given to the Year Twelve student who has the highest combined score across their best five General subjects at the end of Term Three.

Criteria:

- Not all subjects have the same proportion of assessment completed at this stage of the year so scores will be converted into a score out of 100 (a score out of 20 for each subject).
- The 'scaling' of subjects will not be taken into account at this point.
- In the event of a tie a sixth subject may be taken into account as a tie-breaker. If they still remain tied, dual awards will be presented.
- The final decision of the Mueller College Dux is at the discretion of the Head of College.

Caltex All Rounder

The Caltex All-Rounder is awarded to the student who most closely meets the criteria for the award as provided by Caltex.

For over a quarter of a century, the Caltex Best All Rounder Award has earned a reputation for being one of Australia's most respected secondary education recognition programs. It has been presented to thousands of final-year students, acknowledging their all-round contributions to their schools and communities.

As 2020 has involved severe restrictions in opportunities for students to contribute in many of these areas. For this year only, Year 11 contributions will also be considered in the areas of leadership, service, sport and the arts.

Caltex suggests that recipients should excel in six key categories:

- **Academic** – achieves scholastically across a range of subjects.
- **Attitude** – willing to help others; makes selfless contributions.
- **Personal conduct** – exemplary at all times.
- **Leadership** – is a role model for other students.
- **Service** – participates fully in school and community activities.
- **Sport** – represents the school without necessarily being a champion.
- **Arts** – participates enthusiastically in the cultural and artistic life of the school
