By now you would have heard the Queensland Government announcement concerning schooling in Term 2.

It has been decided that Mueller College will operate in line with the Government's decision, outlined below.

- School will officially resume on Tuesday 21 April 2020
- Mueller College will move to a home-based, online learning model for the first 5 weeks of Term 2
- During this period, all students who are able to stay home should do so
- Students who must come to school will be supervised and access the same online materials for their education

Next Tuesday will have a strange feeling. Instead of getting ready and coming to school, your child/ren will need to get ready and log on to iLearn. The next few days will be a good time to set up a suitable study location and make sure your devices are able to log in iLearn. Coursework will be made available on Tuesday morning.
